

## Les Crestes 2020

**Fruity, fresh and expressive.  
A genuine young and delicious Priorat wine.**

**Varieties:** 20 year-old Red Grenache vines (80%), old Carignian (10%) and Syrah (10%).

**Soil:** Grapes grown exclusively on steep slate "licorella" hillsides (350/450m.) with yields of 1kg/vine.

**Climate:** Mediterranean with a continental trend. High thermal contrast between night and day.

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**Elaboration and aging:** grapes picked by hand using 10 kg. boxes. Selection in vineyards and at the entrance of the winery. Classification berry by berry on a double sorting table in the winery. Aging of 8 months in second year French oak barrels.

**Bottling:** 40,000 bottles in December 2021. Unfined and unfiltered.

**Alcohol content:** 14.5% vol. **pH:** 3.23 **Total acidity:** 6.5 g / L

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### Vintage 2020

Early vintage. As a result of high temperatures, the plants started their vegetative growth between 2 and 3 weeks earlier than usual. This advance of the cycle, together with the intense spring rains and the high temperatures, generated the "perfect storm" for the development of Mildew fungus. A dry summer sped up the ripening process, so the harvest started a week earlier than usual. Healthy grapes were high quality with lower yields.
